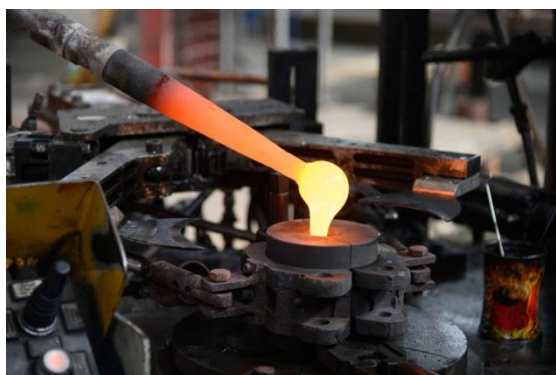




GLASS MUSEUM





Significance of the asset:

The unique nature of the Glass Museum is presupposed by the fact that it is the only museum in Bulgaria of this kind. It has been established as part of the old glass factory in Beloslav, working since 1893, where the glass processing is still made through both manual production and semiautomatic manufacturing.

The Glass Museum has preserved the history of the manufacture as the specific nature favours its culture heritage value. The museum exhibition shows glassware from the century-old manufacturing tradition of the Beloslav glassblowers. Variety of glassware products can be seen here: small bottles for perfumery, cosmetics, alcohol and spices and technical glasses, unique small-scale hand-made products, souvenirs and molds. There are hundreds of vases, cups, candlesticks and animals each of which is hand-blown and different from the others, as well as countless vases of various colors and shapes.

Visit to the museum can be made either through the main road connecting Varna and Beloslav or by boat along Varna and Beloslav lakes which makes it more attractive and distinctive place. Moreover the museum can be visited even in the evening as the glass processing is a continuing non-stop process.
