WONDERFUL ROCKS







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Significance of the asset:

The Wonderful Rocks is a unique rock phenomenon not far from the sea proudly stepping into the River. It is a collection of several sharp rock towers located on the banks of the Tsonevo lake - the third largest lake in Bulgaria, the main tributary of the Kamchia River - one of the largest rivers in Bulgaria.

The whole area of Tsonevo Lake and the gorge of the Luda Kamchia River is a picturesque scene and deserve a special break from the road to enjoy the views and active recreation in the nature, including fishing, rock climbing, cycling, walking and more. The places in the nearby villages offer accommodation so that people can spend a few days exploring the area.

The Wonderful Rocks phenomenon is a group of rock formed as a result of the erosion activity of the river waters during the formation of the gorge of the Luda Kamchia River. One of the rock groups resembles a castle that looks even more majestic.

In these parts of the Eastern Pre-Balkans some of the key discoveries in the area are revealed, which give the clearest idea of its geological evolution. The discoveries around the site are known in the geological literature as the "section at the Wonderful Rocks" and reflect specific sedimentary sequences that can only be observed in this region and are unique to the territory of Bulgaria.

The sight to these rocks proudly rising above the water surface and glancing intently at it proves that the name exactly fits the place – fascinating rock castle with a majestic reputation over the centuries.
